Project need

We're looking for a skilled recruiter that is passionate for the arts who is looking to give their time to a contemporary arts non-profit in need of specialized expertise.

Time Commitment:

1-3 months. 3-8 hours a week. Ideal time frame: April 15th, 2019 to June 15th, 2019

Location:

Oakland, CA. Can be done remotely.

Why Now?

ASG is facing a challenging moment in our history. We are facing displacement from our current location due to rent hikes and other non-negotiable lease terms and have now started the process of seeking alternative solutions and fundraising plans.

Our challenge comes a time where our growth as an arts organization has otherwise been momentous. Over the past few years, we've grown from an artist-run space into a nationally funded non-profit with recognition and awards from renowned institutions such as the National Endowment for the Arts, Andy Warhol Foundation, Zellerbach Family Foundation, Kenneth Rainin Foundation, and Creative Work Fund. Despite substantive traction, we are still losing our current physical location and now face the challenge of securing and fundraising for a new long term home, while keeping our programming moving forward.

To accomplish these goals, we need your help during this pivotal moment. With the right expertise and support, ASG can have a bright future in the Bay Area as a vehicle for ground-breaking multi-media, installation, and experimental video works that push forward challenging conversations and create new worlds of thought.

What we need from you:

- Help ASG recruit 10-20 highly-skilled and/or highly-networked volunteers to help us effectively plan and execute a successful fundraiser.
- Provide feedback to volunteer project descriptions.
- Outreach to prospective volunteers and post on relevant recruiting channels (eg. LinkedIn, Volunteer Match, Taproot, tech company volunteer boards, etc.)
- Meet with prospective project volunteers and facilitate the onboarding process.
- Keep ASG Board members and Staff apprised of progress as needed.

What we have already:

- Tremendous community support and connections from Bay Area artists and arts non-profit organizers.
- Volunteer SOWs, similar to this one, for each of the 10-20 roles we need to fill
- A range of skilled volunteers and part-time staff
- Active board and operations infrastructure

What's in it for you:

This is an opportunity for a self-motivated individual to take the reins on an interesting project, think creatively to help shape the future of ASG, meet cool people and have fun doing it.

What does success look like:

This project will be successful once we fill each of the 20 or so short-term volunteer position and successfully convert one or two of those volunteers into a longer term Board of Directors position. This particular group of highly-skilled volunteers will be helping ASG successfully execute our largest fundraiser ever.
